## SMART4ALL awards a total of 320.000 € to 4 projects in its 2<sup>nd</sup> Open Call on Focused Technology Transfer Experiments (FTTEs)



4 projects across South Eastern and Central Europe will be funded (with 80.000 € each) by SMART4ALL project, in the context of its 2<sup>nd</sup> Open Call on Focused Technology Transfer Experiments (FTTE). Within this type of experiments, which will be executed by consortia consisted of two different entities (industrial or academic) from at least two different eligible European countries, one party transfers to the receiving partner a specific HW or SW technology in order to enable improved product or processes.

The Open Call ran from 15<sup>th</sup> of July until 15<sup>th</sup> of September 2021. Candidates were invited to submit their application online at <a href="https://smart4all-2nd-ftte.fundingbox.com/">https://smart4all-2nd-ftte.fundingbox.com/</a>. The proposals had to fall under one of the following domains: Digitized Transport, Digitized Environment, Digitized Agriculture, or Digitized Anything.


The 4 winning proposals in the 2<sup>nd</sup> FTTE are:

- 1. **EOSystem**, Energy Optimized drone-based healthcare delivery System, formed by **AB ZERO srls** (Italy) and **UNIVERZA V LJUBLJANI** (Slovenia)
- 2. MilkTrack, NIR sensor & tracking platform for daily diary processing, formed by Mantispectra b.v. (Netherlands) and AgriTrack.io (Greece)
- **3. POP-LEC,** Power Profiler for Low Energy Computing, formed by **NplusT srl** (Italy) and **PCB Design Kft.** (Hungary)
- 4. TempSens, formed by NISS d.o.o. (Montenegro) and The Industrial Systems Institute (ISI) (Greece)

The 4 winning consortia were selected amongst 75 applications that included entities from 29 different countries including member states of the European Union and H2020 associated countries. The five countries with most applications were Greece (26), Serbia (17), Slovenia (12), Montenegro (11) and Italy (11), while Croatia (7). United Kingdom (6), Bosnia &

Herzegovina (6), Germany (6) and Bulgaria (5) followed in the ranking of the most populated countries in this Open Call. Excluding Greece, approximately 92% of all submitted applications included at least one partner from the SEE countries.

The verticals with most applications received were Digitized Anything with 23 applications, Digitized Environment with 18, Digitized Agriculture with 16, and Digitized Transport with 15 applications.



This was the second of three Open Calls on Focused Technology Transfer Experiments. Throughout the 48 months of the SMART4ALL project, entities will be able to submit their proposals in 4 more open calls, 9 total since the launch of the project: 3 KTE Open Calls, 3 FTTE Open Calls, 3 CTTE Open Calls. The 3rd FTTE Open Call will launch in June 2022 and an official date has yet to be communicated.
